



PUSH TRUCKS AND WRECKERS

Push truck and wreckers are permitted to enter the pit area if they follow the following rules and regulations. You are allowed in this area to assist with the running of the racing program at a safe, efficient and fast pace. Push truck operators are considered sub-contractors at the Clinton County Speedway and are required to assist with the running of the racing program by pushing sprint cars and restarting and removing any car needing assistance.

At no time should you take any chances of any kind. SAFETY IS A HIGH PRIORITY TO EVERYONE - YOU, THE TRACK AND THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE SHOW. By signing the weekly release, it is interpreted that you have read and understand these rules and regulations.

1. At each event you will be assigned to cover a specific area of the racetrack and help in the pit area. However, if necessary, you will be asked to help in other areas.
2. Racecars, vehicles (including towing equipment), wreckers, push trucks and any other equipment located in the pit area or restricted area are NOT covered by insurance.
3. Driver must be at least 18 years of age with a valid driver's license.
4. Push trucks mean trucks; no cars or mini vans will be permitted
5. All push truck operators must fill out an official registration form and submit it to speedway management. Approved applicants for the season will be notified.
6. Push trucks are permitted to have a helper with them riding in the cab. No one is permitted to ride on the back at any time.
7. Wreckers are permitted to have two (2) helpers. Helpers are permitted to ride on the back but must hold on with both hands at all times. It is recommended that the driver remain in the cab at all times to help speed up the show.
8. No kids under the age of 12 are permitted in the trucks while the trucks are on the track.
9. All push trucks must help run in the track when requested to do so. The track management will make every effort to have the track ready before race time
10. You are required to remain at your vehicle whenever there is action on the track.
11. No reckless driving or hot rodding when on the racetrack. No clowning around or yelling at spectators in the grandstand - you are in full view of everyone.
12. No alcoholic beverages permitted in the pit area at any time.
13. Help out whenever asked. Remember you are permitted in the pit area to help; spectating comes second.
14. All push trucks and wreckers must share in the work-load equally. Be fair to everyone. Anyone not sharing equally, will not be permitted to re-enter the pit area for future events.
15. Whenever a caution occurs, look to the closest official for instructions. Be prepared to move quickly.

16. Don't report to any red flag accident (condition) on the racetrack, let the speedway emergency crews proceed first. Safety is always the number one priority. Remember your job will only start when their job is finished.

On a red flag situation, cars are to stop where they are on the racetrack. Once the emergency has ended, enter the speedway and pick up a car and move it to the area as directed to do so by officials. Be sure to keep the track exits clear for emergency vehicles.

17. Whenever removing a car from the racetrack, exit via the closest exit to help speed up the show.

18. NEVER push a car onto the track from the pits, unless the yellow lights are on.

19. Whenever pushing a car in the pit area, proceed with extreme caution.

20. Push trucks and wreckers should try to register at least 1 /2 hour prior to warm-ups.

21. Emergency lights are recommended, but not required. Emergency lights should only be used when you are on the racetrack. Four-way flashing lights or parking lights should be used in the pit area and not the emergency lights because they may distract competitors on the speedway. Make sure to turn off all emergency lights when exiting the speedway.

22. When pushing of cars for the start of the feature or after red flag stops, start with those cars at the front of the pack.

23. If your vehicle represents a business, write down your ad and our announcer will plug your business.

24. All trucks must have a wood bumper.

25. Whenever a caution occurs, look to the closest official for instructions. Be prepared to move quickly.

26. Whenever pushing a car in the pit area, proceed with extreme caution. If a car needs to be fired in the pit area, be extra careful and blow your horn to warn anyone who might be in the area.

27. When pushing the sprint cars for the start of the feature or after red flags and fuel stops, start with those cars at the front of the pack.

28. When starting the sprint car, always wait for the driver to indicate to you to push and release the car when driver holds up his hand with a stop motion.

29. SPRINT CAR ENGINE STARTS, HOT LAPS & QUALIFYING EVENTS: Sprint cars will slowly be pushed out of the pits at a slow speed and shall come to a stop. Cars will then be fired going down the backstretch and into turn three (3) when driver is ready.

30. SPRINT CAR FEATURE: All cars will slowly be brought to the speedway and rolled to a stop on the front stretch. If less than half the field is on the track, proceed around and pick up a second car to bring to the track. Starting at the front, pick up a sprint car and wait for the pace truck to start. Driver will let you know when he/she is ready to be pushed. Make every effort to open up a clear lane on the top side of the speedway. Continue around the speedway and track officials will let you know whether to exit the speedway or continue around to pick up a second car.

31. Scanners/Radios are recommended in order to receive the tracks radio transmission so you will be aware of current situations on and off the track.

Termination can be by phone, text, oral, or written communication.

This application does not constitute an agreement or contract for privileges for any specified period or definite duration. I understand that no representative of the speedway is authorized to make any assurances to the contrary and that no implied oral or written agreements contrary to the foregoing express language are valid unless they are in writing and signed by the speedway's owners. Clinton County Speedway and its management is not responsible for any damage that may occur to my personal property while on the property. I hold them harmless from any and all claims that may occur. I hereby assume all risks associated with my participation as a volunteer at the Speedway. I have read and understand and agree with the Release Form. I understand that I must sign and accept content of this Release every time I sign in at the Speedway.

I certify that I have read, fully understand and accept all terms of the foregoing statements and agree to follow all rules set forth by Clinton County Speedway management.
