



Four Cylinder Division Claim Form

To ensure parity in the Four-Cylinder Division, there is a car claim rule. This form is to must be completed and submitted to the speedway office 15 minutes prior to the start of the Four-Cylinder Feature Event.

Criteria and Procedure for Claim:

- A driver must win a minimum of 2 Feature Events during the current racing season to be eligible for a claim.
- Claim form must be submitted and signed by the car owner and include \$500 submitted to the Speedway Office at least 15 minutes prior the start of the feature event
- Claim is a swap of cars. You agree if the claim is submitted and accepted, you will swap your car for the claimed car. The only equipment not part of the car swap is the driver's seat and safety equipment including belts or fire suppression equipment and transponder if equipped
- Swap will occur immediately following the race. You can not intentionally damage the car in any way following the race.
- Claimed Car and Claimer must both finish on the lead lap. If 20-24 cars are in competition, both cars must finish in the top 10. If 15-19 cars are in competition, both cars must finish in the top 8. If 10-16 cars are in competition, both cars must finish top 5. If less than 10 cars in competition, both cars must finish in the top 3.
- The driver of the car being claimed has the right to refuse the claim. If the driver refuses the claim, he/she will forfeit all points and money earned that night.
- Once the claim is submitted, the Speedway will retain a \$75 fee regardless of the outcome of the claim.
- If the claim is denied, the remaining \$425 will be returned to the claimer. If the claim is accepted, the driver of the claimed car will receive the \$425.
- Only one claim per race season permitted
